RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (Oral)

The petitioner belongs to *Aad Dharmi* caste which has been declared as a Scheduled Caste. He is an Ex-Serviceman.

Whether the petitioner appeared on 16.3.2011 before the Recruitment Board, Jalandhar or not is a seriously disputed question of fact which cannot be gone into in writ jurisdiction on affidavits since evidence would be required to be adduced.

Dismissed with the liberty to avail remedy in the Civil Court if advised, to resolve the disputed issue as to whether the petitioner had appeared for the interview in the process of recruitment of constables initiated in the year 2010.
