The instant petition has been filed for quashing the impugned letter dated 24.11.2014 (Annexure P-4) issued by respondent no.4 and letter dated 09.12.2014 (Annexure P-5) issued by respondent no.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that representation dated 08.01.2015 (Annexure P-6) has already been made by the petitioner but no action has been taken. She confines her prayer for a direction to decide Annexure P-6.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, however, without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and without issuing notice to the respondents at this stage, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 Deputy

Commissioner, Ambala, to look into the grievance of the petitioner, as

narrated in Annexure P-6 and redress the same in accordance with law within one month from receipt of copy of this order and communicate the same to the petitioner. .
