HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The petitioner was allotted the work of furnishing and interior work of newly constructed auditorium of the Mahatma Gandhi, State Institute of Public Administration, Sector-26, Chandigarh vide order dated 12.11.2013 (Annexure P-1)

It is stated that the petitioner had completed the work on 30.06.2014. However, the during the execution of the work, the same was increased and the respondents asked the petitioner to execute to the tune of Rs. 7,16,00,880/-. After execution of the work, total running payments amount to Rs.5,81,92,039/- have been released in favour of the petitioner but the balance payment of Rs.1,34,00,884 are not being paid to him. Despite repeated requests to the respondents-authorities, no action to make the payment has been taken.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to take a decision on its claim as contained in the representation dated 19.02.2015 (Annexure P-12).

Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take a decision on its claim as contained in the representation dated 19.02.2015 (Annexure P-12) regarding release of the balance payment to the petitioner expeditiously, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
