HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The petitioner was allotted the work of widening, raising and strengthening of Baba Nanki Marg (Kapurthala-Sultanpur Lodhi Road including Kapurthala Bye-pass) Length = 30.14 Kms, vide allotment letter dated 13.06.2011 (Annexure P-1).

It is stated that the petitioner had completed the work on 24.08.2015 to the satisfaction of the respondents but still Rs. 63,66,856/- are due from the respondents. Despite repeated requests to the respondents-authorities, no action to make the payment has been taken.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to take a decision on its claim as contained in the representation dated 11.09.2015 (Annexure P-5).

Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to take a decision on the representation dated 11.09.2015 (Annexure P-5) regarding release of the outstanding payment to the petitioner expeditiously, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
