Prayer in the present writ petition is for regularization of the services of the petitioner, in view of the Government policies dated 04.03.1999 (Annexure P1) 23.01.2001 (Annexure P2) and 15.12.2006 (Annexure P3) and in view of the judgments passed by this Court. Additional relief regarding pay fixation, regular pay scales and arrears of pay, has also been prayed for.

It is the case of the petitioner that he was appointed as part-time Sweeper by the respondents for the office of the Treasury Officer, Moga on 01.10.1994 and was working continuously since then and has been paid salary of Rs.700/- per month.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if the demand notice dated 11.08.2015 (Annexure P8), served upon the respondents, is decided within a time-bound period. He also places reliance upon the judgment of this Court in CWP No.1933 of 2014 titled *Kanta Rani Vs. State of Punjab & others*, decided on 28.10.2014, to submit that part-time employees are also entitled for the benefit of regularization.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case and without calling upon the respondents, keeping in view the limited relief sought, the present writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.2 to take into consideration the demand notice dated 11.08.2015 (Annexure P8) and take appropriate decision, within a period of three months, from the receipt of a certified copy of this order. Needless to say that if the relief is to be denied, reasons are to follow.
