LISA GILL, J.

It is submitted that the petitioner is the only surviving legal heirs of the deceased - Om Parkash. He was the petitioner's son. He was working as Inspector in the Municipal Council, Fazilka on regular basis but unfortunately lost his life on 27.05.2013 in a motor vehicle accident alongwith his wife and son. Respondents have not released family pension and the other benefits due towards the petitioner on account of death of her son Om Parkash despite number of reminders and personal representations as well. All clarifications sought by the department have been afforded by the petitioner but still no action has been taken.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed at the time of arguments, facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to look into the matter and decide petitioner's claim by passing a speaking order,

preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Present writ petition be treated to be a representation on behalf of the petitioner. In case, the petitioner is found entitled to any benefit, same be released within a period of six weeks from the date of passing of said order.

Present writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
