Learned State counsel informs that the entire retiral benefits has been paid, the delay occurred on the part of the petitioner's husband as he is not facing inquiry proceedings and the requisite documents were not supplied by the petitioner.

Keeping in view the fact that the entire payment is made to the petitioner, therefore no case is for interference is made out.
