HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The petitioner was appointed as Mortar Mate (Labourer) on 01.05.1996 to the office of respondent No.3. The grievance of the petitioner is that though he is entitled to the regularization but his case for regularization is not being considered by the respondents.

For claiming the aforesaid relief, the petitioner has been repeatedly representing to the respondents but to no avail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to take a decision on the legal notice dated 23.12.2014 (Annexure P-3).

Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to take a decision on the legal notice dated 23.12.2014 (Annexure P-3) expeditiously preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
