G.S.SANDHAWALIA, J. (Oral)

The petitioner seeks the relief of appearing in the examination of B.B.A. (3 years) Course started in the session 2014.

It is the case of the petitioner that on account of non payment of 3rd semester fee, he had been stopped mid way from attending the classes and therefore he should be permitted to deposit the fee. The ground for non payment of the fee is stated to be his father's ill health and poor financial position. Reliance upon the recommendation of the Principal of the respondent no.2-College on the application dated 6.10.2015 (Annexure P/2) has been made.

However, the said stand has not been supported by the said respondent in its written statement. It is submitted that the fee was to be paid by 6th July, 2015 and upto 13.8.2015 with late fee with the approval from the University. The petitioner had approached for the first time on 21.8.2015 for taking admission in the 2nd year and classes had commenced from 8.7.2015 and the petitioner had not attended a single class. He had only approached once on 21.8.2015 and after that on 6.10.2015.

Similarly, respondent-University in its reply has submitted that

minimum 75% attendance is required and the teaching had already ended and examination is to start on 20.11.2015, therefore, the petitioner is not eligible.

In such circumstances, no relief can be granted to the petitioner who seeks a direction contrary to the statute of the University.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed.
