The petitioner's prayer for issuance of a writ of mandamus to respondents No. 2 and 3 for removal of illegal possession on government and non-government land appears to be a prima facie attempt to convert a civil dispute regarding private property into a dispute relating to public land. We, therefore, are not inclined to issue the writ, as prayed for, but relegate the petitioner to his remedy of filing a civil suit.
