Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents no.2 and 3 to take action against respondent no.6 for misappropriation of public funds, while holding office of Sarpanch.

In this writ petition, there is no material documents placed on record to show that any amount has been misappropriated by respondent no.6. Present writ petition is lacking in many aspects.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to file a fresh

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one after obtaining information under RTI Act and after annexing the relevant documents.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
