Counsel for the respondents state that the claim made in the present writ petition is covered against the petitioner in judgment passed in *Civil Writ Petition No.28009 of 2013* titled as *Vikash Versus Union of India*, decided on 17.09.2014, against which the *Letters Patent Appeal No.1707 of 2014* titled as *Vikash Versus Union of India and others*, stands dismissed on 13.10.2014, where it has been held that the enhancement of the minimum academic qualification prescribed for allotment of LPG Distributorship by the Oil Corporation is in accordance with law.

I have perused the prayer made in the writ petition and am of the view that the assertion made by the counsel for the respondents is

correct. The prayer made in this writ petition is covered against the petitioner in the judgment passed by this Court in **Vikash's case** (supra).

The writ petition, therefore, stands dismissed in same terms.
