RAJIVE BHALLA, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners' grievance against order dated 10.07.2015, passed by the Financial Commissioner, Haryana, in our considered opinion, is entirely misconceived.

The Financial Commissioner, Haryana has accepted the revision filed by the petitioners and directed the Commissioner, Gurgaon Division, Gurgaon, to record a finding based upon the material on record whether the land, in dispute, was reserved or not for common purposes, during consolidation. The petitioners, in our considered opinion, should have been satisfied by this order, which set aside the adverse order passed by the Commissioner, holding that the petitioners have not been able to prove that the land, in dispute, is not Jumla Mushtarka Malkan.

Consequently, the writ petition is dismissed by directing the Commissioner, Gurgaon, Division, Gurgaon, to decide the matter pending before him within three months, from receipt of a certified copy of this order.
