Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the case is squarely covered by an order dated August 11, 2014 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP No.16048 of 2013 (Arjan Dass vs. Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd. & Others). The aforesaid order has been passed against the respondent-Corporation in a similar matter which reads as follows:-

“Prayer in the present writ petition is for issuance of a direction to grant the benefit of promotional increment in view of the circular dated 23.04.1990 and for release of interest @ 15%, when the amount became due.

In the written statement, the claim has been admitted and it is submitted in para no.13, as under:-

“Para 13 of the writ petition is denied. The petitioner will be granted the promotional increment w.e.f. the date he is eligible but he has to make an application for that purpose and the

arrears will be restricted to 38 months before he has served legal notice dated 29.5.2013 upon the answering-respondents.”

In view of the above averment, counsel for the petitioner submits that he will move the necessary application.

Accordingly, it is directed that on submission of such application, the respondents shall process the case of the petitioner and make necessary payments within a period of 2 months from the receipt of the said application.

With the above said direction, the present writ petition is disposed of.”

Consequently, this petition is disposed of in the same terms. However, compliance of the order dated August 11, 2014 will run for the same period, but from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
