The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of order dated 06.05.2013 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.2 and also for issuance of direction to the respondents to add five years of service of the petitioner for the purpose of superannuation pension.

Learned State counsel has placed on record a copy of order dated 23.04.2015 and vide the same order, the remaining period of three years of the petitioner has been considered as qualifying service and sanction has also been accorded.

In view of submission made by learned State counsel, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to release necessary benefits in view of sanction order dated 23.04.2015 as expeditiously as possible.
