G.S.SANDHAWALIA, J (Oral)

The petitioner seeks admission under the category of Economically Backward Persons (EBP) in the Diploma Course of Veterinary and Livestock Development.

The pleaded case of the petitioner is that his case was not considered for admission in the said category in view of the order passed by this Court on 27.7.2015 which was further clarified on 18.9.2015. It is the further case of the petitioner that there were ten seats for the said category in various institutes and thus he was entitled for consideration.

Respondents no.3 and 4 in their reply have taken the defence that there were more than 30 students who have scored more marks than 61 marks which were scored by the petitioner. Even for the EBP category the petitioner was not within the zone of consideration though he was considered for the general category.

Resultantly, keeping in view the factual aspect, this Court need not to go into the merits as to whether there was any discrepancy in non consideration of the petitioner for the said course. Even if now his merit is taken into consideration in the said category, he is not liable to be granted admission and there are several candidates higher in merit than him.

Accordingly, finding no merit in the present writ petition, the same is dismissed.
