LISA GILL, J.(ORAL)

It is contended that a sum of Rs.2,07,715/- only has been received on account of retiral benefits of the petitioner's late husband Sh. Satish Kumar Bhaskar. Petitioner served a legal notice dated 25th July, 2015 (Annexure P-11) upon the respondents for release of rest of benefits but still no action has been taken thereon till date. It is submitted that respondent No.3 be directed to decide the petitioner's claim for the benefits due in a time bound manner.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed at the time of arguments, facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy, it is considered expedient to dispose of this writ petition with a direction to respondent No.3 to expeditiously decide legal notice dated 25.07.2015 (Annexure P-11) submitted by the petitioner by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of four months from receipt of certified copy of this order. Benefits, if any found due to the petitioner shall be released expeditiously preferably within a period of six weeks thereafter.

Writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
