The petitioner is aggrieved by a noting made by the respondents on 18.11.2014 to the effect that the petitioners are not considered capable of handling more work due to the slow progress shown by them.

The petitioners had filed writ petition i.e. CWP No. 24620 of 2014, which was disposed of by an order dated 02.12.2014. The Division Bench noticed that the petitioners had filed the representation and the petitioners were granted liberty to pursue the same. The petitioners accordingly filed the further representation on 04.12.2014. The petitioners' grievance is that their representation

has not been decided till date.

The writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to dispose of the representations dated 27.11.2014 (Annexure P-5) and 04.12.2014 (Annexure P-6), in accordance with the provisions of the law, on or before 30.04.2015.
