Challenge in the present writ petition is to the final answer key prepared by the respondents for the purpose of short-listing the candidates for the written examination of Haryana Civil Services (Judicial Branch).

The grievance of the petitioner is in respect of deletion of five questions as well as to the final answer key in respect of question Nos.32 and 100 of Code 'A' Set.

The legality of deletion five questions as well as answer key in respect of question No.32 has been examined by this Court in CWP No.2117 of 2015 titled 'Ankita Mittal Vs. State of Haryana and others' decided on 09.02.2015, whereas the issue in respect of question No.100, which is question No.120 in Code 'C' Set, has been examined separately in CWP No.2120 of 2015 titled 'Ms. Tanya Rohilla Vs. The Registrar, Punjab & Haryana High Court & others' decided on 09.02.2015.

For the reasons recorded in Ankita Mittal and Ms. Tanya Rohilla's cases (supra), we do not find any merit in the present writ petition. The same is accordingly dismissed.
