PARAMJEET SINGH, J.(Oral)

This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of mandamus directing respondent No.1 to make arrangement for payment of salary to Urdu knowing retired Qanugo.

It is pleaded that there was difficulty in preparing the revenue record i.e. *field book* and *lattha* as no person knowing Urdu was available with the Department. Retired Qanugo knowing Urdu was subsequently appointed to do the job but he was not paid his salary so he could not proceed with the matter.

Now, in the reply dated 12.01.2015 filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 it is mentioned by the SDM, Mukerian that they

have received a grant of Rs.96,000/- as payment for a period of 8 months @ Rs.12,000/- per month, the work with regard to *Shijra Latha* and *Musavi* and the other documents will be completed.

In these circumstances, this petition is disposed of with the direction that the record shall be reconstructed preferably within 6 months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
