Pursuant to the order of this Court dated 21.11.2014, learned counsel for the respondents has placed on record a short reply, by way of an affidavit of the Senior Executive Engineer, Operation Division, PSPCL, Anandpur Sahib, on behalf of the respondents, showing that retirement benefits as were due to the petitioner have been paid to him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that the petitioner retired on 30.04.2013, but most of the retirement benefits have not been paid till recently, though payments under certain heads were paid intermittently in the year 2014.

This petition is, consequently, disposed of with a direction to the respondents to calculate interest under all heads of retirement benefits paid to the petitioner, running from 01.05.2013 till the date that payments were actually made under each head. Interest on all such heads as carry a

statutory rate of interest as per the Punjab Civil Services Rules/Punjab Financial Rules, shall be calculated at such rate and in respect of all other heads which do not carry a statutory rate, interest @ 7% per annum shall be calculated and the entire amount of interest so calculated shall be paid to the petitioner within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
