It is the admitted position that against the impugned order dated 07.10.2013 (Annexure P-9), the petitioner has preferred an statutory appeal under Section 68 of the Punjab Cooperative Societies Act, 1961, which is pending before the Joint Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Patiala Division, Patiala-respondent No.2.

Accordingly, at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the appeal filed by the petitioner by passing a speaking order and after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, preferably within three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

It is further directed that the protection granted to the petitioner through interim order dated 03.12.2013 would continue till the date of the decision of the above said appeal.

Needless to add that the decision so taken be communicated to the petitioner and if the decision is not to the satisfaction of the petitioner, he would be at liberty to challenge the same, in accordance with law.
