Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that at this stage, he would be satisfied if the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to take a decision on the representations dated 19.08.2015 submitted by petitioner No.2 and 26.3.2015 submitted by petitioner No.1 (Annexures P-6 and P-7 respectively).

I find the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners to be reasonable.

Accordingly, at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to take decision on the representations dated 19.08.2015 submitted by petitioner No.2 and 26.3.2015 submitted by petitioner No.1 (Annexures P-6 and P-7 respectively) by passing a speaking order and after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioners, preferably within four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Needless to add that the decision so taken be communicated to the petitioners and if the decision is not to the satisfaction of the petitioners, they would be at liberty to challenge the same, in accordance with law.
