RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J.(Oral)

Having regard to the written statement filed by the State of Punjab, it is apparent from Annexure R-1 and affirmed in para 3 of the written statement that Raghubir Singh, son of Dhian Singh was offered a job from the oustees quota from the category of J & K Oustees by appointment letter No.17-24 P-55, March, 1997 and pursuant to which Raghubir Singh joined. The present petitioner Sanjay Singh is the brother of Raghubir Singh and son of Dhian Singh, grandson of Santu and therefore, quota for oustees family has been satisfied. Since the scheme envisages appointment to be offered to one member per family, therefore, the petitioner has no right to appointment and the petition is, accordingly, dismissed when one member of the family has been appointed and is earning in the Ranjit Sagar Dam.
