HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The petitioner joined respondent-Federation as Salesman on 28.04.1981 and he is due to retire on 30.11.2015 after completing 34 years of service. His grievance is that he has not been granted the benefit of 2nd and 3rd ACP despite repeated representations and legal notice having been submitted to the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the claim as contained in the legal notice dated 10.07.2015 (Annexure P-5).

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 10.07.2015 (Annexure P-5), expeditiously, preferably, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
