Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that for claiming regularization w.e.f. the date when the juniors have been regularized, a legal notice dated 4.8.2014 had been submitted to the Director General, School Education to consider the claim of the petitioner to regularize him w.e.f the date when his juniors have been regularized. He further submits that as per seniority list Annexure P-6 the petitioner is senior to the persons who have been regularized w.e.f. 25.2.1999. He confines his prayer for issuance of appropriate direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice in accordance with law by keeping in view the seniority list dated 30.6.2003, the order dated 20.2.2002 passed by this Court and order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 22.3.2010.

The prayer is fair and justified. Respondent No.2 is directed to decide Legal Notice (Annexure P-10) which is to be

treated as representation and decide the same in accordance with law by keeping in view the seniority list dated 30.6.2003, the order dated 20.2.2002 passed by this Court and order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 22.3.2010 within a period of two months and in case the petitioner is found to be eligible to be regularized w.e.f.the date when his juniors have been regularized, appropriate orders may be passed within a further period of two months and in case claim of the petitioner is found justified the same should be decided by passing a detailed and speaking order and the said order be conveyed to the petitioner.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
