Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent no.2 to decide the election petition titled as “Rajpal Vs. The Animal Husbandry, Cooperative Societies and others” filed by respondent no.4, pending before respondent no.2 – Deputy Registrar, Cooperative Society, Hisar.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent

no.4 filed an election petition before respondent no.2 on 10.09.2014. Till

date, no decision has been taken thereon. Learned counsel further submits that service is already complete in the election petition and the same is fixed for today. Learned counsel further states that direction may be issued to respondent no.2 to decide the election petition within a stipulated period.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and after perusing the paper-book, instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 – Deputy Registrar, Cooperative Society, Hisar to decide the election petition (Annexure P/2) in accordance with law preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
