LISA GILL, J.

It is submitted that petitioner retired on 31.08.2015. A sum of ₹2,10,000/- only has been received on account of retiral benefits. Rest of the amount is not being released by the respondents despite representation dated 29.09.2015 (Annexure P-2). It is prayed that respondent No. 4 be directed to decide said representation in a time bound manner and afford benefits due to the petitioner.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed at the time of arguments, facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 4 – Municipal Council, Fazilka to expeditiously decide representation dated 29.09.2015 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of four months

from receipt of certified copy of this order. Benefits, if any, found due to the petitioner shall be released expeditiously preferably within a period of six weeks thereafter.
