The petitioner seeks the relief of declaration of the result of Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) for the session 2012-13 and for issuance of the Detailed Marks Certificate (DMC). Reliance has been placed upon the order passed by this Court in CWP No.4114 of 2014 titled *Seema Rani Vs. Kurukshetra University & another*, decided on 05.03.2014 (Annexure P5).

The pleaded case of the petitioner is that he had done his three years Bachelor Degree course in Arts from Kurukshetra University and the DMC dated 25.06.2005 has been appended as Annexure P1. Thereafter, he had passed his Masters Degree in Economics from the Eastern Institute for Integrated Learning in Management University, Sikkim (EIILM), through distant education. He had taken admission in the B.Ed. course for the session 2012-13 with respondent No.2-C.R. College of Education, Hisar, affiliated to respondent No.1-University and was issued Roll No.410095. The verification of his documents, issued by the EIILM

University had been sent to the said University on 05.04.2013 (Annexure P3). The respondent-University had declared the result of the B.Ed. course on 31.10.2013 but the persons who had passed the Master Degree and Graduation Degree from the EILM University, their result had not been declared. It is submitted that representations dated 05.03.2014 and 16.09.2015 were made and legal notice dated 29.09.2015 (Annexure P7) has been served upon the respondent-University for declaration of the result but of no avail.

Keeping in view the limited controversy and especially keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has done his Graduation from the respondent No.1-University itself, which would make him eligible for applying for B.Ed. course, irrespective of the admission taken for the Masters Degree in the EILM University, this Court is of the opinion that the respondent-University should take a decision upon the representations and the legal notice served. The petitioner be intimated regarding his result in respect of the Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) course, within a period of 4 weeks from the receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case of the declaration of the result of the petitioner, the Detailed Marks Certificate be also issued to him. In case the result is not to be declared, the petitioner be communicated the reasons for the non-declaration of the same.

With the abovesaid observations, writ petition stands
disposed of.
