JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Petitioner in the present petition has challenged the order dated 25.09.2012 (**Annexure P-8**), passed by the Deputy Commissioner, Faridabad whereby he has been suspended from the Office of Sarpanch; further challenge is to the order dated 11.11.2014 (**Annexure P-9**), passed by the Financial Commissioner, Haryana, whereby his appeal has been dismissed.

Upon notice, reply on behalf of the respondents has been filed.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the respondent-State points out that apart from the fact that petitioner was suspended, pending a regular enquiry which has not yet been concluded, the claim against suspension has become infructuous since the term of the previous Panchayat has expired and an Administrator stands appointed to look after the functioning of the Panchayat till the newly constituted Gram Panchayat.

In view of the statement of learned State Counsel, the present writ petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
