LISA GILL, J.

It is submitted that petitioner retired on 31.07.2015. A sum of ₹2.5 lacs only has been received on account of retiral benefits. Rest of the amount is not being released by the respondents despite various representations. It is prayed that respondent No. 3 be directed to decide representation dated 30.09.2015 (Annexure P-2) being the last one submitted by the petitioner, in a time bound manner and afford benefits due to the petitioner.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed at the time of arguments, facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3 – Municipal Council, Rampura Phul to expeditiously decide representation dated 30.09.2015 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the

petitioner by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of four months from receipt of certified copy of this order. Benefits, if any, found due to the petitioner shall be released expeditiously preferably within a period of six weeks thereafter.
