In the instant petition, the petitioner has impugned the order dated 16.07.2015 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Deputy Commissioner, Union Territory, Chandigarh. The same order was challenged by other lessee, namely Amarjit Singh Bhurjee, by filing CWP No. 23268 of 2015, which was disposed of by this court on 31.10.2015, while passing the following order :
