The petitioner has sought a writ of mandamus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to decide his application for environmental clearance to enable him to seek permission from respondents No.5 to 7 to extract minerals and utilise the brick earth for manufacturing of bricks at his brick kiln.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents No.3 and 4 states that pursuant to the order passed by National Green Tribunal applications will be considered within six months. The statement is accepted. As far as prayer (iii) is concerned needless to mention that it is necessary for the State Government to take action in accordance with law in respect of any erring party.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
