Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents no. 2 to 4 to renew the gun licence issued to the petitioner expeditiously.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has moved representations dated 04.04.2013 and 16.08.2015 (Annexure P/3-Colly) for renewal of arm licence. Learned counsel further submits that criminal proceedings against the petitioner have already been completed in the year 1999, but till date no decision has been taken on the representations (Annexure P/3-Colly)

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sandeep S. Mann, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to take a decision on the representations dated 04.04.2013 and 16.08.2015 (Annexure P/3-Colly) in accordance with law, preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and copy of the order so passed shall be communicated forthwith to the petitioner.
