HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The petitioner is claiming step up of his pay at par with his junior namely Dharam Pal, who was promoted prior to him on the post of Mandi Supervisor on the basis of reservation.

The only grievance of the petitioner is that despite sending various representations to the respondents, no decision has been taken so far. Lastly, legal notice dated 01.06.2015 (Annexure P-10) has also been served upon the respondents but that too of no avail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he is entitled to the relief claim in the light of the instructions dated 27.11.2006, 23.11.2009 and 18.12.2013 (Annexures P-5, P-6 and P-7). He further states that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the legal notice dated 01.06.2015 (Annexure P-10).

Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the legal notice dated 01.06.2015 (Annexure P-10) in accordance with law expeditiously, preferably, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
