Notice of motion.

On our asking, Mr. Anil Mehta, learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Let four copies of the writ petition be supplied to the State counsel during the course of day failing which this order shall be automatically recalled and the writ petition shall be deemed to have been dismissed for non-prosecution.

In view of the nature of order which we propose to pass, it is not necessary to seek any counter-reply from the respondents at this stage.

The petitioners are aggrieved by non-inclusion of their names in the final voter list of village Jagoli, Tehsil and District Ambala. According to them, they are in possession of several documents like Birth Certificates, Aadhar Cards etc.

etc. to substantiate their claim re: bonafide residents of village Jagoli.

Since the above-stated claim has been put up by the petitioners before the District Electoral Officer, Ambala vide representation dated 28.09.2015 (P-8) also, it is not expedient for us to express any views on merits except to issue a direction to respondent Nos.3 & 4 to ascertain the correct facts and if need be to hold a fact-finding enquiry and take an appropriate decision well before the Gram Panchayat elections are held.

The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
