The petitioner has challenged the auction of booth nos.17 to 20. Petitioner contends that booths ought not to be allowed to function at the location. The petitioner's apprehension probably is that the competition would increase. That cannot be a ground for setting aside the decision to allot booths. The petitioner's other grievance is that the facility of parking for the public in general which were available on these sites is now not available. If booths are allowed to be constructed and there is no law prohibiting the same, the authorities' right to construct booths cannot be interfered with on that ground. The petitioner has not right in respect thereof himself.

The petition therefore is dismissed.
