The petitioner has challenged the expulsion order dated 21.10.2015 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No.4-college, namely, Sharda Mahila Mahavidyalaya Singhani, District Bhiwani.

While issuing notice of motion, the petitioner had limited his relief to issue of migration from respondent No.4-college and the right of giving forthcoming examination.

Counsel for respondent No.2-University on the last date had assured this Court that the petitioner could be adjusted in some other institute by resorting to migration B.Sc 2nd Year (3rd Semester).

Today, communication dated 02.12.2015 has been placed on record, whereby the petitioner's migration has been

allowed to GDC Memorial College, Behal, Bhiwani, subject to depositing the necessary fee to the new college.

Counsel for the respondent No.2-University submits that the admit card for sitting in the examination has also been issued to the abovesaid college and the petitioner can obtain the same from the college and sit in the examination, which is to commence from 24.12.2015 onwards. However, it is pointed out that the tuition fee and other necessary charges from the date of migration will be liable to be paid by the petitioner, which the petitioner's counsel assured that the same will be deposited.

It has been clarified that the examination fee has already been deposited by the petitioner and therefore, the petitioner will not be entitled to pay that again.

With the above understanding, the present writ petition is disposed of.

The Principal of GDC Memorial College will ensure that the issuance of the roll number is done, subject to the above conditions.

In case the petitioner does not deposit the requisite fee, her result can be withheld by the college/university.
