Present writ petition has been filed on the basis of resolution dated 27.03.2015 (Annexure P/15) in which there is no mention of the names of the persons who are in unauthorized possession. Since, there is no specific resolution, writ petition is not maintainable. Otherwise also, scheme of the consolidation is also not on the record of paper book.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to file a fresh one with better particulars.

Instant petition appears to have been filed in casual manner and has resulted into wastage of the precious time of the Court, hence, the petitioner must be burdened with costs.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty subject to costs of Rs.10,000/-, to be deposited with the State Legal Services Authority, Punjab.
