C.M. No.3366 of 2015

The aforementioned application has been filed by the applicant-petitioner for placing on record the order dated 13.02.2015, passed by the Deputy Commissioner, Jind as **Annexure P-7**, whereby it is stated that he has been removed from the post of Sarpanch, Gram Panchayat, Karkhana.

For the reasons stated in the application, duly supported by the affidavit of applicant-petitioner, the Civil Misc. Application is allowed and order dated 13.02.2015, passed by the Deputy Commissioner, Jind is taken on record as **Annexure P-7**.

C.M. No.872 of 2015

The aforementioned application under Order 1 Rule 10 CPC has been filed by the applicant/complainant-Prem Singh son of Sh. Neki Ram for his impleadment as respondent No.3 in the present writ petition.

CWP No.24867 of 2014

The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner-Ranbir Singh, Sarpanch primarily against his suspension vide the impugned orders dated 11.11.2014 (**Annexure P-1**) and seeks restoration of order dated 05.06.2014 (**Annexure P-2**), passed by the Deputy Commissioner, Jind reinstating him as Sarpanch, Gram Panchayat, Karkhana.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the applicant/complainant-Prem Singh in CM No.872 of 2015 states that the present writ petition challenging the suspension has become infructuous in the light of the aforesaid application of the petitioner that he has since been removed from the post of Sarpanch, vide order dated 13.02.2015 (**P-7**).

Learned Counsel for the petitioner has not been able to refute the said factual contentions.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is dismissed as infructuous. However, he is free, if so advised, to seek his remedy against order dated 13.02.2015 (**P-7**) in accordance with law.
