

Ram Avtar Vs. Pawan Kumar and ors.

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On 05.12.2015, learned counsel and representatives of the Insurance Company agreed to enhance compensation by ₹1,20,000/- more in this appeal and made the statement. Today, learned counsel for the appellant has agreed to accept the same and made the statement to this effect. Hence, a sum of ₹1,20,000/- (₹ One Lac Twenty Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the MACT is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim. As suggested by learned counsel for the appellant, the enhanced amount would be paid to the appellant – Ram Avtar, by way of cheque.

Learned counsel for the Insurance Company prays for time for submitting cheque for the agreed amount in the name of appellant – Ram Avtar, as desired by learned counsel for the appellant.

We dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit the cheque with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 30.01.2016, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till

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payment from the date of this order. The appellant(s)'
counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the
Lok Adalat.

and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
