The grievance of the petitioner in the instant writ petition is against non-adjudication of the appeal filed by him under Section 11 (2) of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961, which is pending consideration before respondent No.2 since 19.07.2011. The appeal has been filed in a matter where the petitioner alleges that the Gram Panchayat land, i.e., shamlat deh is unauthorizedly occupied by private-respondents. The petitioner thus seeks a direction to the Appellate Authority to decide his appeal at the earliest.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and considering the nature of relief sought by him, however, without expressing any views on the merits of his claim, we

dispose of this writ petition with a direction to respondent No.2 to take up the appeal said to have been filed by the petitioner and decide the same at the earliest but not beyond three months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.
