The petitioner prays for issuance of a writ of certiorari, quashing order dated 11.09.2012 (Annexure P-6), passed by the Collector-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Karnal, accepting an appeal filed by respondents No.4 to 7 and remitting the matter to the District Development and Panchayat Officer-cum-Assistant Collector, Ist Grade, Karnal, to decide the question of ownership afresh.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that as the Gram Panchayat has taken possession, he does not press the petition any more but prays that the District Development and Panchayat Officer-cum-Assistant Collector, Ist Grade, Karnal, may be directed to

decide the matter expeditiously.

Counsel for the respondents state that they have no objection to the prayer made by counsel for the petitioner.

We have heard counsel for the parties and in view of statement made by counsel for the petitioner, dispose of the writ petition as infructuous but with a direction to the District Development and Panchayat Officer-cum-Assistant Collector, Ist Grade, Karnal, to decide the matter expeditiously preferably **within four months** from receipt of a certified copy of this order.
