Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was regularized on 12.11.2014 and he was initially appointed on 05.07.1983 and therefore, the judgment of the Division Bench in **Harbans Lal Vs. State of Punjab 2012 (3) SCT 362** would be squarely applicable, which has further been upheld by the Apex Court and the review application has also been dismissed. In spite of that, the G.P.F. Number has not been allotted and the daily wage/ad-hoc/work-charge services, rendered by the petitioner, has not been counted towards qualifying service.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has filed representation dated 26.10.2015 (Annexure P5) with respondent No.3, to that effect and he would be satisfied if a time-bound decision is taken by the said respondent on the representation filed.

Keeping in view the limited relief sought, this Court does not feel it necessary to call upon the State to file the reply. Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the representation dated 26.10.2015 (Annexure P5), within a period of 3 months, from the receipt of a certified copy of this order, keeping in view the binding precedent of the Division Bench in the case of Harbans Lal (supra).
