By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the respondents to release the full pension, commuted pension and other retiral benefits along with interest @ 12% per annum from the date it became due till realization.

The learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Sh. Tarlochan Singh, Lower Division Clerk, PSPCL, City Division, Hoshiarpur, states that the entire retiral benefits will be released within three months from today.

In view of the statement made, the present is disposed of.

However, as the petitioner retired on 29.02.2012, the petitioner is at liberty to move appropriate representation with regard to interest on the delayed payment before the competent authority. The respondents shall consider the same in the light of law laid down in case **The Financial Commissioner and Principal Secretary to Govt. of Haryana, Irrigation Department, Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh Vs. Hasan Singh Kanwar, 2010(1) SLR 788.**
