LISA GILL, J.

Petitioners pray for grant of benefit of pay fixation, seniority etc. to which they are entitled on regularisation of their services as per policy dated 15.12.2006 (Annexure P-7); with a further prayer to consider them under old pension scheme instead of New Defined Contributory Pension Scheme by counting the period of services rendered by them on daily wage/adhoc basis prior to their regularisation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that despite legal notice dated 15.04.2015 (Annexure P-18) served upon the respondents, no action is being taken by the authorities thereon. At this stage, it is prayed that the respondents be directed to decide said legal notice in a time bound manner and afford benefits due to the petitioners.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed at the time of arguments, facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to expeditiously decide legal notice dated 15.04.2015 (Annexure P-18) submitted by the petitioners by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of four months from receipt of certified copy of this order.
