The instant writ petition has been filed praying for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus for directing the respondents to grant to the petitioner pay parity with alleged junior namely Anil Kumar.

The pleadings on record are grossly insufficient to consider and to examine the claim of the petitioner inasmuch as the details with regard to initial appointment of the alleged junior i.e. Anil Kumar, initial pay scale, subsequent promotions etc., are lacking.
