LISA GILL, J.

It is contended that retiral benefits due to the petitioner are not being released despite specific directions issued on 30.07.2015 (Annexure P-1) by Deputy Registrar, Co-operative Society, Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that legal notice dated 21.09.2015 (Annexure P-2) has been served upon the respondents but to no avail. At this stage, it is prayed that the respondents be directed to decide said legal notice in a time bound manner and release retiral benefits to the petitioner.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed at the time of arguments, facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to expeditiously decide legal notice dated 21.09.2015 (Annexure P-2)

submitted by the petitioner by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of four months from receipt of certified copy of this order. Benefits, if any, found due to the petitioner shall be released expeditiously preferably within a period of six weeks thereafter.
