The petitioner is a registered Rickshaw-pullers' union of Sangrur. The grievance of the petitioner is that though only 15 auto rickshaws have been registered for plying outside the Municipal Limits of Municipal Committee, Sangrur, but hundreds of auto rickshaws are running in the said area unchecked. It is stated that such unauthorised rickshaws are adversely affecting the livelihood of the members of the petitioner union, besides they cause inconvenience to the general public and are also causing a lot of noise and air pollution. The petitioner union has submitted number of representations to the respondent authorities, but no action has been taken. Learned counsel has referred to representations Annexures P-2, P-7, P-8, P-9, P-11 and P-12.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states, that at this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied, if directions are issued to respondent No.2 to look into the grievance of the petitioner Union, as contained in the above representations.

In view of above, without commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievance raised by the petitioner Union in the representation dated 8.9.2015 (Annexure P-11) and take necessary action as may be warranted in law. The needful be done expeditiously, preferably within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
