Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, he would be satisfied if the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the legal notice dated 28.09.2015 (AnnexureP-14), issued on behalf of the petitioner.

I find the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner to be reasonable.

Accordingly, at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the legal notice dated 28.09.2015 (AnnexureP-14), issued on behalf of the petitioner, by passing a speaking order and after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, preferably within two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Needless to add that the decision so taken be communicated to the petitioner and if the decision is not to the satisfaction of the petitioner,

the petitioner would be at liberty to challenge the same, in accordance with law.

Since the petitioner has been serving the respondents for the last over six years I deem it just and appropriate that till the decision on the aforesaid legal notice dated 28.09.2015 (Annexure P-14), the petitioner be not relieved from service.
